February is Registration Month!



Registration for the 2023-2024 school year will be taking place during the month of February. If you have a child or know someone in the neighborhood who has a child that will be five years old on or before **December 31st, 2023**, they are eligible for school in September 2023. If your child is four years old on or before December 31st they are eligible for pre primary in September 2023. Early registration is important as it will be a factor in our staffing for the next school year. We will require the following information from you when registering your child: Child's Birth Certificate, Proof of Address, and Child's Health Card Number. Please note that we cannot accept any registrations without a birth certificate.


